RESPECTIVE FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS AND PRINCIPAL IN RELATION TO ADMISSIONS

The Board of Governors draws up the admissions criteria and delegates to an Admissions Sub-Committee, which includes the Principal, the responsibility for applying these criteria. Any reference herein to the term the Board of Governors includes any Committee or Sub-Committee appointed by the Board of Governors for the purposes of applying the Admissions Criteria set out herein.

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA 2021

The criteria as set out below will be applied to all children resident in Northern Ireland at the time of their proposed admission to the school before any child not so resident may be selected for admission.

If the school is over-subscribed, then pupils will be admitted up to the admissions number according to the following criteria applied in the order set down.

- 1 Pupils who have an older brother(s)/half-brother(s)/sister(s)/half-sister(s) or legally adopted sibling(s) presently enrolled.
- 2 Pupils who are transferring from the following contributory primary schools.
 - Artigarvan Controlled PS
 - Ashlea Controlled PS
 - Ballougry Controlled PS
 - Bready Jubilee Controlled PS
 - Culmore Controlled PS
 - Cumber Claudy Controlled PS
 - Donemana Controlled PS
 - Drumahoe Controlled PS
 - Ebrington Controlled PS
 - Eglinton Controlled PS
 - Fountain Controlled PS
 - Greenhaw Controlled PS
 - Lisnagelvin Controlled PS
 - Londonderry Model Controlled PS
 - Newbuildings Controlled PS
 - Oakgrove Integrated PS
- 3 Pupils with special medical, social or other circumstances which make it necessary in the opinion of the Board of Governors, that they should attend this school rather than another school.
- 4 The three family connections below will be applied in the order set down.
 - (a) Eldest child in a family.
 - (b) First application received from a family with no previous connection with the school.
 - (c) Sibling who attended the school in last 6 or more academic years.
- 5 Other pupils.

In the event of there being more pupils meeting the last criterion which can be applied then selection for all places remaining in this category will be on the basis of initial letter of the surname, in the order set out below:

V N P T U K S M MC D I Q X O H Y W G J Z L B C F A E R

The order was determined by a randomised selection of letters of the alphabet.

In order to select pupils for admission in 2021 the Board of Governors has delegated to the authorised sub-committee consisting of the Principal, Vice-Principal and three Governors, the responsibility for applying these criteria.

It is the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardian(s) to provide **ALL** the relevant information on the Transfer Application.

The same criteria are applied to those seeking admission to Year 8 – after the beginning of the school year.

The Board of Governors reserves the right to require such supplementary evidence as it may determine to support or verify information on any Application Form/Transfer application

The provision of false or incorrect information or the failure to provide information within the deadlines set by post-primary schools can result in the withdrawal of a place and the inability to offer a place on the part of any school nominated on the applicant's Transfer Application.
