Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am writing to inform you that year 11 students will finish school on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> June. In recent days we have become aware of increasing rates of Covid 19 leading to a number of our pupils having to self-isolate. Although there is no cause for concern at this point, I am conscious of the fact that we are not able to accommodate Year 11 pupils in class bubbles as they must travel to subject specific rooms. This means that Year 11 pupils are most likely to contract and/or transmit any infection to other children or adults in school and I wish to avoid this.

I understand that for a number of families, finishing school for Year 11 pupils on 25<sup>th</sup> June could prove to be an inconvenience. Therefore, pupils in Year 11 who are unable to remain at home can attend school, but will remain in small supervised bubbles.

Pupils in years 8-10 should attend school on 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> June as planned. Pupils can wear non-uniform on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June and are asked to make a £1 donation to school funds. School will finish at 11:45am and buses will be available.

May I take this opportunity to thank you for your support over the past year and wish you a safe and happy summer.
