RESPECTIVE FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS AND PRINCIPAL IN RELATION TO ADMISSIONS

The Board of Governors draws up the admissions criteria and delegates to an Admissions Sub-Committee, which includes the Principal, the responsibility for applying these criteria. Any reference herein to the term the Board of Governors includes any Committee or Sub-Committee appointed by the Board of Governors for the purposes of applying the Admissions Criteria set out herein.

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA 2023

The criteria as set out below will be applied to all children resident in Northern Ireland at the time of their proposed admission to the school before any child not so resident may be selected for admission.

If the school is over-subscribed, then pupils will be admitted up to the admissions number according to the following criteria applied in the order set down.

- 1 Pupils who have another child of the family currently enrolled in the school.
- 2 Pupils who are transferring from the following contributory primary schools.

- 3 Pupils who are the eldest child of the family to be eligible to apply for admission to the school
- 4 Other pupils.

In the event of there being more pupils meeting the last criterion which can be applied then selection for all places remaining in this category will be on the basis of initial letter of the surname, in the order set out below:

J K S V M T M c L O Y D N Z G M a c P I R C Q H F U B A E W X

The order was determined by a randomised selection of letters including Mac and Mc.

In order to select pupils for admission in 2023 the Board of Governors has delegated to the authorised sub-committee consisting of the Principal, Vice-Principal and three Governors, the responsibility for applying these criteria.

It is the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardian(s) to provide **ALL** the relevant information on the Transfer Application.

The same criteria are applied to those seeking admission to Year 8 – after the beginning of the school year.

The Board of Governors reserves the right to require such supplementary evidence as it may determine to support or verify information on any Application Form/Transfer application

The provision of false or incorrect information or the failure to provide information within the deadlines set by post-primary schools can result in the withdrawal of a place and the inability to offer a place on the part of any school nominated on the applicant's Transfer Application.
